


Adult Pneumococcal Vaccine Administration Algorithm

**For ages ≥19 years: patients who are immunocompromised, have a cochlear implant, or known CSF leak, PPSV23 may be given at a minimum of 8 weeks after PCV15 to minimize risk of invasive pneumococcal disease.

†If PPSV23 is unavailable, PCV20 can be given instead of PPSV23.

‡‡ If PCV13 previously given at any age, give PPSV23 ≥1 year later to healthy adult at age ≥65 years. For persons ≥19 years with medical condition or immunosuppression, see [Pneumococcal Vaccine Timing for Adults](#).
