Purpose: Chapter 246-71 WAC, Medical Marijuana Authorization Database and 246-72 WAC, Medical Marijuana Consultant Certificate. The Department of Health (department) has adopted rule revisions to replace the term "marijuana" with "cannabis" in response to passage of Second Substitute House Bill 1210 (chapter 16, Laws of 2022).
The department has adopted other clarifying changes such as changing terms such as "gender," citations, and spellings throughout both chapters. These updates are general corrections for accuracy and readability. These additional technical changes are not referenced in the bill and include removing gender pronouns as well as removing the requirement to identify gender in the medical marijuana authorization database. The changes will not affect the intent or meaning of the rule.
