Who is eligible?

Uninsured and underinsured adults ages 18 and older. For this program, adults are considered underinsured if their insurance requires any copay for a COVID-19 vaccination.

The Bridge Access Program is dedicated to ensuring cost-free COVID-19 vaccines for all. This program is for individuals without insurance or those who have an insurance that requires any copay to receive a COVID-19 vaccine. If you have insurance and the vaccine is covered in full, you are not eligible for this program.



The Bridge Access Program is funded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
