


Fly Washington Passport Program

PATCH DESIGN CRITERIA

The Fly Washington Passport Program is seeking designers to create a patch representative of one of the six Washington State regions. The patch will be awarded to pilots who fly into all of the participating airports open for public use within a region and can be proudly displayed on a flight jacket.

Use your creative talents to design a patch representative of one of the following regions:



Olympic - South Central - Southwest - Northwest - North Central - Eastern

Criteria:

- Size: 3 to 4 inches (height and width)
- Can be circular or some other shape
- Should reflect the particular region or landmark associated with the region
- Consider that the design will be an embroidered patch
- Okay to use multiple colors
- Include the name of the region in the patch design
- Send in jpg format
- Brief description of patch's significance to region
