To: DDA Staffed Residential Home and Group Care Facility Providers

Re: Temporary rate add-on related to COVID-19 pandemic

Description:

Effective July 1, 2022, the temporary rate increase for community residential providers is decreased 20 percent from the current amount. This temporary rate increase changes from current 11.3% to 7.3% in order to reduce the cost of the increases in accordance with the ESSB 5693 (2022 Supplemental Budget Bill) Section 204(1)(u), which states that, "Beginning July 1, 2022, the rate add-ons shall be reduced by 20 percent every two fiscal quarters."

Information regarding future reductions to your temporary rate increase will be sent prior to the change. The agency must maintain all records, per DDA Policy.

Staffed Residential Home Providers:

An exception to DDA Policy 6.22, is being granted for all DDA Staffed Residential Home (SRH) providers authorized to provide out-of-home services. This exception allows SRH providers to use the temporary additional funds to address staffing, supplies and other administrative/non-staff costs that the agency may incur as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. This temporary increase is added to the total daily rate for each client through Dec. 31, 2022, in the form of a rate add-on equal to 7.3 percent of the total daily rate of each client in your contract.

Licensed Group Care Facility Providers:

DDA Group Care Facilities supporting medically complex children will also receive a temporary rate add-on based upon DDA contract 1721-XP. The intent of the temporary add-on funds is to address staffing needs, additional supplies and other administrative/non-staff costs that the agency may incur as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. These additional funds will remain in your contract through Dec. 31, 2022, in the form of a rate add-on equal to 7.3 percent of the total rate of each client in your contract.
