Joseph M. Macbeth, CEO and Chief Executive Officer of the National Alliance for Direct Support Professionals

Joseph Macbeth has worked in the field of intellectual and developmental disabilities for 40 years - beginning as a Direct Support Professional. In 2016, Joe was appointed by New York Governor Andrew Cuomo as a Member of the Advisory Council for the New York State Justice Center for the Protection of People with Special Needs. In 2017, for the President's Committee

for People with Intellectual Disabilities, Joe co-authored the President's Report *America's Direct Support Workforce Crisis: Effects on People with Intellectual Disabilities, Families, Communities, and the U.S. Economy*. In 2019, Joe was recognized as a National Honoree by the National Historic Recognition Project for significant national contributions in the field of intellectual and developmental disabilities in the US between the years 2000 and 2020. Most recently, Joe was appointed by President Joe Biden to the President's Committee for Intellectual Disabilities – where he will serve a two-year term.

General Podcast Information:

Just In Time is a 30-minute, bi-monthly podcast series, which is essentially an *on-demand* talk radio show. This means listeners do not listen to a live broadcast but are able connect, via their phones or computers, to a taped version of the broadcast anywhere and anytime they like. Listeners can easily access DDA's podcast on their phones while multi-tasking at work, driving home, on their breaks, over lunch, during exercise, or during a quiet moment at home.

Podcast Format:

Just-In-Time will follow the same format for each episode:

Introduction

(1-2 minutes)

Main Message

(interview, instruction, dialogue, or presentation by guest: 18-19 minutes)

Provider Recognition

(10 minutes)
