



Dan Thompson Memorial Developmental Disabilities Community Services Account

History of the Account

The Developmental Disabilities Community Services Account was created in 2005 after the death of Dan Thompson under Revised Code of Washington (RCW 71A.20.170).

Expenditures from the account must supplement, and may not replace, supplant or reduce current state expenditure levels for supports and services in the community for eligible persons with developmental disabilities. The account may be spent only after state legislative appropriation.

DSHS solicited recommendations from the Washington State Developmental Disabilities Council on the spending of the account.

In 2021, the account received \$50 million from the Washington State Legislature.

Implementation Status

- Over 100 proposals received from DDC
- 98% of projects received were funded




Smaller Awards are more Numerous than Bigger Ones

Contracts per award amount




Community-Based Priority Area is Most Common
