Round 2 Application Opens

DSHS' Developmental Disabilities Administration has released the Round 2 application for funding from the Dan Thompson Memorial Developmental Disabilities Community Services Account. The application opened on Dec. 1, and closes at 5 p.m. PST on Jan. 19, 2024. DDA facilitated two technical assistance sessions on Dec. 5 and 11, to provide an opportunity for question/answers for interested organizations. Awardee Showcase – Courageous Connections

Courageous Connections, located in Snohomish County, received two grants from the Dan Thompson Memorial Developmental Disabilities Community Services Account. <u>Courageous Connections</u> mission is to promote the physical and emotional development of people of all ages and unique abilities through safe, therapeutic, outdoor experiences with horses. They provide healing, learning and growing through experiences with horses.



During a recent site visit, DDA staff were able to tour the farm, meet the horses, and meet staff. Their programs offer participants, of all ages and abilities, a safe and unique opportunity to partner with horses while working from the ground. Their staff are CPR, first-aid, automated external defibrillator-trained, Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International certified and Trauma Informed Care skilled. From the very beginning their vision has included "the acquisition of a farm property that encourages interactions with nature where all are treated with kindness and respect."
