




Types of Professions

As a **Direct Support Professional**, you will be working as an employee for an agency that provides 24-hour instruction and support services in supported living or group homes. You can work for a private agency or for a state operated agency (SOLA).

As a Companion Home Provider, you will contract with DDA to support one individual who lives in the home with you.

As an **Alternative Living Provider**, you will be a contracted provider for DDA. You can set your own schedule and work with one or more individual in the home and in the community.

Direct Support Professionals



Direct Support Professionals work for a community provider that offers 24-hour instruction and support services to people with disabilities. Individuals who receive services live in their own homes with supported living, or in a group home to promote their personal power, choice, and full access to the greater community. DSPs work in the individual's home and help the individual maintain skills or learn new skills at home and in the community.
