Your chance to shape the future of Apple Health (Medicaid) services has arrived. The newly formed Apple Health Advisory Council is looking for people who receive intellectual and developmental disability or long-term care services from the state. Your feedback can improve the program for nearly 2 million Washington residents!



Why join the Apple Health Advisory Council?

- Compensation: Members are paid for their time (\$57 per hour up to \$200 per day)
- Share your voice: Give feedback directly to inform programs, policies and services.
- Make a difference: Represent your lived experiences with Medicaid services and be heard.

Meetings are virtual and start this fall. Estimated time commitment is 2-3 hours per month for the first few months, plus 1-2 hours every other month. Members serve on the council for a one-year term. Interpreter service is available on request.

Apple Health coverage includes home and community-based services including personal care and residential services as well as primary care and emergency visits.
