### CORE CAMPAIGN MESSAGES

### MESSAGE 1

Staying home and avoiding all non-essential contact with others is the most important thing all of us can do to slow the spread of COVID-19.

Everyone, even people who are young and healthy, must stay home to slow the spread of COVID-19. You should:

- Stay at home and avoid all non-essential contact with others.
- Limit trips for groceries, gas, and other things you and your family need.
- If you must go out, stay at least 6 feet apart from others at all times.
- Wash your hands with soap frequently and avoid touching your face.

COVID-19 is highly contagious and each face-to-face interaction is an opportunity for it to spread.

Stay home and help slow the spread!

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MESSAGE 2

While staying apart, we must stand together.

Just because we have to stay apart doesn't mean we can't stand together. Now, more than ever, we need to count on each other for help, support, and understanding.

No matter who you are, what you do as an individual impacts the health of the entire community, and what we do as a community impacts all of us as individuals. You should:

- Stay connected. Staying physically apart does not mean losing connections to family, friends, and community. Set up calls with those you regularly see in person. Call, email, and text friends and acquaintances to ask how they're doing and how you can help.
- Support local businesses. If you can, order meals for delivery or pick-up. Look for small businesses that can ship online orders for the things you need.
- Be a good neighbor. Put together an email list for your apartment building, neighborhood, and friends and family. It makes it easier for people to contact and support each other.

Together, we'll get through this.

MESSAGE 3

Healthcare needs your help. Our healthcare system is already very stressed due to the COVID-19 outbreak. We need to preserve medical supplies and other resources for those who need them most.

The dedicated people caring for us need our help to reduce the strain on the system. So please:

• Always call first. If you think you have been exposed to COVID-19 and/or you are having symptoms (fever, dry cough, difficulty breathing), speak with your healthcare provider before you go to an emergency room, hospital, or other medical facility.
