How Cities’ Cases are being Handled

Judge Corinna Harn presides on Algona and Pacific city cases at the Maleng Regional Justice Center (MRJC) in Kent. City cases include infractions and criminal citations issued by Algona Police and Pacific Police. Civil matters, such as name changes, small claims, etc., for Algona and Pacific residents will continue to be heard at KCDC’s Burien Courthouse location.

Because portions of the City of Pacific are located in Pierce County, Pacific residents living in Pierce County might be summonsed for jury service in King County District Court.

Get to Know Algona and Pacific

If you are not familiar with Algona and Pacific, the two cities are located south of Auburn and north of Sumner along SR 167 (see map below).
