



Budtender Survey FAQs

Who is collecting this information?

- This anonymous survey is from the Research Program at the Liquor and Cannabis Board (LCB). Visit our [website](#) to learn more about this program.

What are they doing with this information?

- Survey responses may be used to help LCB develop educational materials and/or training for budtenders.
- Key takeaways from the survey results will be shared with cannabis licensees after the survey is done.

How long does it take?

- The survey takes about 10 minutes.

Why does the survey ask demographic questions?

- Demographic responses show if survey takers are representative of Washington's adult population, and help LCB understand if there are any groups of people the survey missed.
- Answers will not be analyzed based on demographic questions in any way that may identify survey takers – responses are anonymous.

Why should I take the survey?

- This survey is a chance for your ideas to be heard and for LCB to tailor educational materials and/or trainings to the needs of cannabis retail employees. The LCB's goal is to be a resource for you.

Who will see the results of this survey?

- The survey is anonymous and completely voluntary. No individual responses will be shared with anyone. The survey does not ask for information that could identify anyone who filled out the survey. This survey was reviewed by the Washington State Institutional Review Board (WSIRB) to make sure it is ethical and uses good study design.

Are there incentives or stipends available?

- The LCB does not have funding to offer any payment to take the survey.
