ACCOMMODATION, TRAVEL, PARKING, BUILDING ACCESS

Accommodation: Wednesday, June 11 (1 night)

If you are coming from out of town, more than 90 miles away, you can request accommodation. You can check-in at 4:00 p.m. on June 11 and check-out before leaving for the celebration, on June 12. We will have an assigned space for suitcases in the living room. We will send more information about this in March 2025.

<u>Important information:</u> If you have a change of plans and end up not needing a hotel room, please contact Isabel Carrera Zamanillo (isabel@frontandcentered.org) **at least 48 hours before the arrival date**. We rely on funds to cover these expenses, so if we do not receive this notice in time, you will be responsible for covering the accommodation costs and reimbursing Front and Centered.

FLYING FROM ANOTHER STATE: We want to welcome those of you who joined from other states to make this program possible. Front and Centered can reimburse for flight tickets in economy class. If you need support arranging your flights, please let Isabel know so she can coordinate with our administrative team.

ACCESS TO THE BUILDING: There are two public entrances to the Pacific Tower: The main entrance, located on the south side of the building (Level 1), and the north entrance (Level B). ADA accessibility is through the building's north entrance. The Panoramic Center is located on the 8th floor.

<u>DIRECTIONS AND PARKING:</u> Metro bus routes 36 and 60 stop right at the tower. Light Rail stops at Beacon Hill Transit Center. From there, you can take Metro bus 36 northbound towards the tower.

*From the south - Take Exit 164A for I-90 E and Dearborn/James Streets. Keep left at the first fork, toward Dearborn/James, and then keep right for Dearborn. Turn right on Dearborn. Then turn left on Rainier Avenue S. Take the first left onto S. Weller Street. Turn left on 12th Avenue S. Continue on 12th over the Jose Rizal Bridge to Pacific Tower.

Turn right on 14th. Stay to the right and turn right at the drive AFTER the tower. Go past the flag circle and park in the West garage. Do not park in the Pacific Medical Clinic Garage on the east side of campus, right off of 14th.

*From the north - Take the James Street exit (165A) and turn left on James. Continue east on James and turn right on Boren Avenue. Then turn right on 12th Avenue. Continue on 12th over the Jose Rizal Bridge to Pacific Tower. Turn right on 14th.

Stay to the right and turn right at the drive AFTER the tower. Go past the flag circle



and park in the West garage. Do not park in the Pacific Medical Clinic Garage on the east side of campus, right off of 14th.

*From the west- Exit at Rainier Avenue North. Continue north on Rainier Avenue (straight through the light at Dearborn). Take the first left onto S. Weller Street. Turn left on 12th Avenue S. Continue on 12th over the Jose Rizal Bridge to Pacific Tower.

Turn right on 14th. Stay to the right and turn right at the drive AFTER the tower. Go past the flag circle and park in the West garage. Do not park in the Pacific Medical Clinic Garage on the east side of campus, right off of 14th.

<u>PARKING LOT</u>: Visitors can enter at either the North or South entrances of the garage, pull up to the gate arm, and pull a ticket. When leaving, visitors enter their tickets and pay by credit or debit card. No cash is accepted. Please press the button on the ticket dispenser if you encounter issues entering or leaving the garage.

The north surface parking lot is currently closed for redevelopment. ADA parking is located in the West Garage on Level P1 (enter the building through the north entrance), and as you enter on 14th Ave., around the flagpole circle in front of the south main entrance.

Street parking is also available.

REFUNDS:

Front and Centered will reimburse you for parking and mileage for your travel to this meeting in accordance with administrative and grant-allowed protocols. <u>Use this refund form</u> (you will be asked to submit your parking receipt as well as documentation needed for grant administration protocols.) We will only process refunds for those who completed the form and included their receipts. We will send payment within TWO weeks of receiving your application form.
