Purpose of the proposal and its anticipated effects, including any changes in existing rules: OSPI is proposing rule changes to allow students enrolled in an institutional education program to be concurrently enrolled in a youth dropout reengagement program. The proposed changes would allow the student to be claimed for a combined FTE that exceeds 1.0. In addition, for all students enrolled in youth dropout reengagement programs, the proposed rule changes to the face-to-face contact requirement for students would expand options beyond in-person communication.						
contact requirement for students would expand options beyond in-person communication. Reasons supporting proposal: RCW 28A.190.070, recently enacted, requires OSPI to develop procedures for school districts to report student enrollment in institutional education and youth dropout reengagement programs starting with the 2021-22 school year. Current rules do not allow a student's enrollment to be shared between an institutional education and youth reengagement programs and do not allow a student enrolled in both to exceed 1.0 FTE in any month.						
For all students enrolled in youth dropout reengagement programs, expanding options for contact requirements and attendance definition to allow for options when in-person contact isn't feasible for all students.
