## Updated Instructions: Annual Homeless Student Data Collection


The review of your districts annual McKinney-Vento student data will be done via a review of data populated to the OSPI Comprehensive Education Data and Research System (CEDARS) data system. The deadline for reviewing this information is Monday October 10<sup>th</sup>.

Students identified as homeless at any time during a school year, as defined in McKinney–Vento Act, Section 725(2), are required to be submitted to CEDARS in District Student File (B), Element B21 – 'Is Student Homeless?'.

Data submitted to Element B21 indicates if the student was identified as homeless at any time during the reporting school year and, if yes, their housing/sheltered status.

Data for students submitted to CEDARS, identified as homeless, is accessed in -

- CEDARS>Reports>Enrollment> District Student Attribute Enrollment
  - Select the 2021-22 school year
  - Organization level to view District or School
  - Attribute Type = Homeless Student
  - Unduplicated count = No
  - Display = Student Details
  - Click on Search



You will be presented with a list of students with the details below provided.





If a review of the student list determines any changes or updates are needed, you will need to make the changes and/or updates within your student information system (SIS) and then resubmit the changes in a 2021-22 CEDARS submission.

Data will be pulled from CEDARS after the close of business on October 10 and will be used to meet the federal McKinney-Vento data reporting requirements.
