Supporting Antiracist School Climate Practices

### Bite (5-10 minutes)

#### Option 1: Listen to Why do Educators need Anti-Racist Training?

#### Discuss with your Team

- What does being an anti-racist educator mean to you? How has that changed over time (or how has it not)?
- Who are you accountable to when doing anti-racist training and practices? How are you holding yourself accountable and addressing implicit biases?
- In what ways can you use your power and privilege to be in solidarity with students, families, community, and team?
- How does your school building/districts' policies and culture support an anti-racist school climate? If not, what obstacles are still placed and how can you address them?

## Option 2: Access and explore Let's Talk - Discussing Race, Racism and Other Difficult Topics with Students

#### Discuss with your Team

- Whose racial and cultural values are being centered within the different programs at your school/district? Which students, families, and communities are being excluded?
- How might discussions about race and other topics look, hear, taste, feel or smell across different communities, learning spaces, and, specifically, within your school building/district?
- How can your school/district invite/include students, families, and community members to co-lead these conversations?

#### Discuss with your Team
