## Opioids & Naloxone Educational Training for School Staff (Virtual)

The Rayce Rudeen Foundation, in partnership with Washington State University, is providing Naloxone training to all school nurses.

We are fortunate to have Nicole Rodin provide this Naloxone training. Nicole is a clinical assistant professor at Washington State University College of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences.

The training will cover:

- Review Washington's state mandate of naloxone and provide current data regarding the increase of opioids, especially fentanyl.
- How naloxone works in the body and its role in opioid reversal.
- Identifying signs and symptoms of possible overdose situations where naloxone might be warranted.
- Learn when to use it (identifying signs of overdose).
- Learn about the different types of naloxone and how to administer it.
- Participants will be able to apply the steps for responding to an opioid overdose.
- School protocol - this will cover storage of Narcan, best practices after administration of Narcan, and support for staff who have administered Narcan.
- Protocol for students who received naloxone and support for the family.
- We will provide a panel of experts at the end of the training for a Q & A session.
