## Identification and Correction of Non-Compliance for 2023–24 – Revised

Notifications of non-compliance regarding the implementation of IDEA were issued via email on September 21st. The notification included a password-protected Excel workbook, titled "IDEA Correction of Non-Compliance Workbook" (Workbook), which includes all the components of the former IDEA Compliance Package (iGrants Form Package 442).

With the discontinuation of iGrants, OSPI has determined that issuing these notifications, as well as the correction and verification of the identified non-compliance, will be completed using a password-protected Workbook sent via email, rather than housing the process within the Education Grants Management System (EGMS). This approach will have the least impact on LEAs and will enable LEAs to maximize use of all their allotted EGMS logins for internal LEA staff.

All issues of non-compliance identified in the Workbook are required to be corrected by the LEA as soon as possible but no later than March 1, 2024 per WAC 392-172A-07010 (3). The completed, password-protected Workbook should be emailed as an attachment to WISM@k12.wa.us. Please note: If the LEA does not complete the identified corrections within the required time period, it may result in a delay in the receipt of federal IDEA funding available to the LEA for the 2024–25 school year and will impact the LEA's 2023–24 Determination Level (see WAC 392-172A-07012).
