## Dispute Resolution Updates

## **CADRE** Dispute Resolution Data

<u>CADRE</u>, the National Center for Appropriate Dispute Resolution, recently updated the following annual data resources:

- The <u>National Dispute Resolution Data Summary</u> (Updated December 2023). The purpose of this national summary is to provide a historical look at dispute resolution data and to assist with the identification of trends and changes in the use of the IDEA dispute resolution processes over time. This summary features data for school years ("SY" July 1– June 30) 2011–12 through 2021–22 drawn from CADRE's National Longitudinal Database.
- 2. <u>Trends in Dispute Resolution under the IDEA</u> (*Updated December 2023*). This one-page analysis details recent national trends in the use of dispute resolution procedures to resolve special education disagreements.

CADRE has also announced that beginning in early 2024, CADRE's National Longitudinal Database will be available on the CADRE website allowing for state-to-state comparisons of dispute resolution data from 2004 to the most current reporting year.
