IDEA Correction of Non-Compliance Workbook – due March 1st

The 2023–24 IDEA Correction of Non-Compliance Workbook (previously known as the iGrants Form Package 442) is due **as soon as possible, but no later than March 1, 2024,** from Local Education Agencies (LEAs) with non-compliance identified through monitoring activities, safety net, LEA data submissions, due process decisions, and indicator performance during the 2022–23 school year. LEAs with identified non-compliance were notified and received a copy of the Workbook via email on September 21, 2023.

Once the LEA has submitted the Workbook to OSPI, the special education administrator(s) from the LEA's local Educational Service District (ESD) will work with the LEA to verify that the corrections have been made and the LEA is currently following the applicable regulatory requirements.
