The Washington DeafBlind Program is pleased to announce open registration for the WA Cohort: Open Hands, Open Access (OHOA) DeafBlind Intervener Learning Modules — Fall Series.

Please share this opportunity with paraeducators and team members. These self-paced online modules are available free of charge (clock hours available for a fee) and offer six clock hours per module. Each module is open 24/7 for three weeks, so participants can engage with the content anytime that works for them. One Zoom meeting is held on the last Thursday of each module window and is **required** for clock hours.

These modules are valuable for anyone supporting students with complex support needs, and learners who are blind or have low vision, deaf or hard of hearing, or deafblind.
