



Seattle artist Janelle Abbott is creating a piece for the Wallingford site (see sketch above). If you have a t-shirt in your drawer that is rarely worn, consider donating it to her art! No matter where you live, you are welcome to make a contribution. Here's how:

1. Take a video of yourself holding your t-shirt and tell the story of the garment/why this t-shirt is meaningful to you.
2. Email your video to: jratzerowaste@gmail.com. We may share your video on social media or our project website. If you wish your video to remain private, please let us know.
3. Cut from the hem to the armhole or sleeve hem on one side seam of the t-shirt then cut widthwise into roughly 2" wide strips. Precision is NOT necessary!
4. Package the t-shirt strips in a clean plastic bag and tape shut. Travel to your local USPS and mail it to: PO BOX 31727 Seattle WA 98103. Please clearly mark your name or email address on the package!
5. Have material scraps leftover? Donate them to [Threadcycle!](#)
