The BRIDGE (Building Resilience & Initiative for Development, Growth, and Employment) program is a specialized Edmonds College initiative for justice-impacted veterans and their families. Leveraging 45 years of expertise, we provide a data-driven, multi-year pathway from incarceration to high-demand, living-wage careers.

A COORDINATED CONTINUUM OF SUPPORT

- **In-Custody:** Flexible, self-paced curriculum delivered via secure correspondence.
- **Family Integration:** 100% online support for partners and families via Canvas and email.
- **Lifetime Partnership:** Ongoing advising and mentorship that stays with you long after release.

- **Future-Proof Careers:** We move beyond “survival jobs” to research-backed, 21st-century career pathways.
- **Family Restoration:** We treat the family as an integral unit, breaking intergenerational cycles of justice involvement.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

We are currently seeking veterans for our pilot program who meet the following:

- **Age:** 30–50 years old.
- **Discharge:** Better than “Bad Conduct” or “Dishonorable.”
- **Family:** Married, in a committed relationship, or supporting adult children.
- **Commitment:** A demonstrated history of pursuing education while in custody.
