MADISON – Wisconsin's corn growers have re-elected three directors to the industry's market order board. Re-elected in District 4 is Calvin Dalton, Endeavor; in District 8; David Adams, Lake Geneva; and in District 9, Whilden (Randy) Hughes, Janesville.

The three will serve three-year terms starting Feb. 1.

The three districts represent the following counties:

- District 4: Adams, Columbia, Juneau, Marquette, Monroe and Waushara
- District 8: Jefferson, Kenosha, Racine and Walworth
- District 9: Green and Rock.

The nine-member Wisconsin Corn Promotion Board is responsible for overseeing the collection and use of about \$1.7 million in assessment fees paid by Wisconsin corn growers. The money is used to support the industry through research, market development and consumer education.
