Dear Wisconsin Children's Safety Advocates:

In May 2019, the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission issued a total of **7 recalls relating to products affecting children**. Attached is a summary of the releases identifying the product, the problem, and what should be done with the recalled product.

We have found that not all of the recalls are picked up by the news media as they occur. This monthly summary will give you the opportunity to review all of the children's product safety recalls for the past month.

KEEP YOUR KIDS SAFE

Release Number: (#19-117) Igloo Products Corp., of Katy, Texas, is announcing the voluntary recall of about 60,000 Igloo Marine Elite coolers. This recall includes only Igloo Marine Elite line of coolers that are white with stainless-steel latches. The coolers were made for use on boats and marine environments.

The Igloo logo is embossed on the metal latch and on the outside of the coolers. The coolers were sold in 54, 72, 94, 110, and 150 quart sizes. "Igloo Marine Elite Cooler" and the quart size are printed on a label on the coolers. The 110 quart model of the cooler has two wheels and a metal handle that can be used to pull the cooler.

Problem: The cooler's stainless-steel latch can automatically lock when the lid is closed, allowing a person to become locked inside the air tight container, posing entrapment and suffocation hazards.

What to do: Consumers should immediately put the coolers out of the reach of children. Contact Igloo for instructions on removing and disposing of the old latch and for a free replacement latch. Release Number: (#19-116) South Shore Industries Ltd., of Canada, is announcing the voluntary recall of about 310,000 Libra style 3-drawer chests. This recall involves Libra style 3-drawer chests of drawers sold in nine colors. Each drawer has one metal handle. The model number is printed on a label on the back of the chest. The chests measure 27½-inches high by 31¼-inches wide and 15½-inches deep and each weighs about 56 pounds. A complete list of the model numbers and colors can be found online.

Problem: The recalled chests are unstable if they are not anchored to the wall, posing serious tip-over and entrapment hazards that can result in death or injuries to children.

What to do: Consumers should immediately stop using any recalled chest that is not properly anchored to the wall, and place it in an area that children cannot access. Consumers should contact South Shore to select one of the following recall options:

- Consumers can receive a full refund with free pick-up of the Chest;
 - Consumers can also remove the drawer slides from one side of the Chest and receive packaging along with a prepaid shipping label from the company to mail in the drawer slides for a full refund; or
 - Consumers can receive a free tip-over restraint kit and can request a one-time free in-home installation of the kit

Release Number: (#19-120) DDA Distributors, Inc., dba Hush Anesthetic, Inc., of Miami Lakes, Fla., is announcing the voluntary recall of about 275,000 Hush gels, sprays and Hush foam soaps. This recall involves Hush gel, spray and foam soap products containing 4% lidocaine. The gel and spray were sold in 2 and 4-ounce sizes and the foam soap was sold in 1.7-ounce size. The bottles are white or black and have printed in green at the front the Hush logo or the phrase Hush and the type of product. The Drug Facts label is on the back. The lot number and expiration date are stamped on the bottom of the container. All lot numbers included in the recall.

Problem: The packaging is not child resistant as required by the Poison Prevention Packaging Act. The products contain lidocaine, posing a risk of poisoning to young children if they put the product on their skin or ingest it.

What to do: Consumers should immediately place the recalled products out of the reach of children and contact Hush for a full refund, a free replacement product or free replacement child-resistant cap. Release Number: (#19-122) Beaba USA, of New York, N.Y., is announcing the voluntary recall of about 5,000 Babycook Neo steam cooker/blenders. This recall involves the Beaba Babycook Neo Midnight and Cloud baby food makers. The Babycook Neo is A/C powered and steams and blends food. It measures about 9 inches wide and 9 inches high with a detachable glass bowl. The Midnight is dark blue with a white handled glass bowl with the reference number 912645 on the bottom. The Cloud is white with a gray handled glass bowl with the reference number 912646 on the bottom.

Problem: The glass bowl can break, posing a laceration hazard.

What to do: Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled Babycook Neo and contact Beaba for a free replacement bowl. Release Number: (#19-126) Revelate Designs LLC, Anchorage, Alaska, is announcing the voluntary recall of about 1,250 Bicycle seat bags. This recall involves Revelate Designs 2019 Terrapin System 14L model bicycle seat bags. The seat bags have a pair of straps with hooks on the top rear of the bag and 4 red loops which the hooks connect to. The bags have Revelate Design logos on the left and right sides and were sold in black, blue, purple and camouflage. The nylon bags measure about 18 inches by 7 inches.

Problem: The straps that fasten the bag to the bike seat can detach and get entangled in the rear wheel of the bike, posing crash and injury hazards to the rider.

What to do: Customers should immediately stop using the seat bags and contact Revelate Designs for repair instructions. Release Number: (#19-747) Gildan Activewear SRL, of Barbados, is announcing the voluntary recall of about 10,600 children's sleep sacks; sold exclusively at AmericanApparel.com. This recall involves a American Apparel brand Baby Rib Collection children's 100% cotton and 90% cotton and 10% polyester-blended knit sleep sacks. They were sold in size 6-12 months and in the following colors: Black, green, gray, light blue, navy, pink, red and white. American Apparel and Baby Rib Collection are printed on a neck label. Made in Honduras and the size are printed on another neck label.

Problem: The children's sleep sacks fail to meet the flammability standard for children's sleepwear, posing a risk of burn injuries to children.

What to do: Consumers should immediately take the recalled sleep sacks away from children, stop using them and contact American Apparel for a full refund or a replacement product of similar value. Gildan Activewear is contacting all known purchasers directly. Release Number: (#19-128) Aegean Apparel, Inc. of Dayton, Ohio, is announcing the voluntary recall of about 500 children's robes and pajama pants. This recall involves Aegean Apparel children's robes and pajama pants. The robe is a 100 percent polyester micro fleece. It is hooded with long sleeves, a belt sewn into the back and two front pockets. The robe is light green with a gray and orange cat print with cat ears sewn onto the robe's hood. The pajama pants are 100 percent polyester in white with a black and gray dog wearing a Santa hat print. Both garments were sold in children's sizes small through extra-large and have "Kings n Queens by Aegean Apparel" on its label.

Problem: The children's sleepwear garments fail to meet the flammability standard for children's sleepwear, posing a risk of burn injuries to children.

What to do: Consumers should immediately take the recalled sleepwear away from children and contact Aegean Apparel for a full refund.
