A Guide to School-Related Insider References

While many attackers cite previous attackers as role models, references to those attackers are often subtle and can easily overlooked. Recognizing these references can help in the identification step of the Behavioral Threat Assessment and Management (BTAM) model. This guide—though not exhaustive—lists various references to names, phrases, and dates that could be cited by potential attackers.

It is essential to consider context when initiating a BTAM process; the totality of circumstance surrounding an individual must be considered. For example, if an individual writes about the attack at Columbine High School, it could be a warning sign of targeted violence or it could be an assigned research project. Please note that individuals using these references may also be engaged in non-violent First Amendment protected activity and all facts should be taken into consideration.

9 April Eric Harris's birthday

20 April **Anniversary of Columbine attack**

Hamster Common reference to the attack because Adam Lanza liked hamsters

Red Lake Senior High School

21 March Anniversary of Red Lake attack

Blades11; Nativenazi; December of the Soul; Neonecrosis; Todesengel Online names used by Jeffrey Weise

Jokela High School

7 November Anniversary of Jokela attack (Finland)

Eric von Auffoin Nickname used by Pekka-Eric Auvinen

Natural Selector89 Nickname used by Pekka-Eric Auvinen, which is based on Eric Harris's writings

and the shirt he wore the day of the Columbine High School attack

Sturmgeist89 Online name used by Pekka-Eric Auvinen

Homo idiocracy Used by Pekka-Eric Auvinen

"Humanity is Used on T-shirt by Pekka-Eric Auvinen overrated"

Catherine Name Pekka-Eric Auvinen gave his gun

2011 Norway Attacks

22 July Anniversary of Anders Breivik's attack

2083 Title of Anders Breivik's manifesto was "2083: A European Declaration of

Independence"

Andrew Berwick Pseudonym for Anders Breivik

Additional Key References

1488 does not refer to the year; "14" refers to a 14-word motto of many white

supremacists: "We must secure the existence of our people and a future for white children." "88" refers to "Heil Hitler" because h is the eighth letter of the alphabet. Several school shooters, such as **Karl Pierson** (Arapahoe High School shooter), **William Atchison** (Aztec High School shooter), and **Seung Hui Cho** used these numbers in their attack propaganda. 1488 has been **used by other**

perpetrators of ideological violence.

"Alea lacta est" Latin for "the die is cast;" attributed to Julius Caesar; Karl Pierson wrote this on

his arm and Marc Lépine (École Polytechnique de Montréal shooter) included it

in his suicide note





The Anarchist Cookbook Provides instruction on making explosives from household materials; owned by various perpetrators of targeted violence such as **Clay Shrout** (killed his family and took a classroom hostage at Ryle High School), **Michael Carneal** (Heath High School shooter), **Kip Kinkel** (Thurston High School shooter), **Eric Harris**,

Jared Loughner (2011 Tucson shooter), and Karl Pierson.

Andrew Blaze Alias for Randy Stair (Eaton Township Weis Markets shooter)

"Born to kill" Phrase used by **Kimveer Gill** (Dawson College shooter)

Angel of Death Used on T-shirt by Dimitrios Pagourtzis (Santa Fe High School shooter)

Day of Retribution Name Elliot Rodger (2014 Isla Vista shooter) used for his attack

Rage Novel by Stephen King published under pseudonym Richard Bachman about a

student who kills two teachers and holds a class hostage. Read by several school shooters, some of whom appear to have imitated the story in their attacks: **Kristofer Hans** (Fergus County High School shooter), **Gary Scott Pennington** (East Carter High School shooter), **Barry Loukaitis** (Frontier Middle

School shooter), and Michael Carneal.

Ragnarok Title of Alex Hribal's (knife attack at Franklin Regional High School) last piece

of writing and perhaps his attack; derived from Norse mythology

"Supreme gentleman" A reference to **Elliot Rodger**–perpetrator of targeted violence in California–in his

final video, he addressed himself to women as the "supreme gentleman." Alek Minassian (Toronto Van attacker) posted "All hail the Supreme Gentleman, Elliot

Rodger," on social media just before his rampage.

Trench Nickname used by Kimveer Gill online, perhaps as a reference to the

trenchcoats worn by **Eric Harris** and **Dylan Klebold** or the Trenchcoat Mafia

Other Notorious Dates by Month

14 February Two school attacks have occurred on Valentine's Day, but no known connection

to the holiday; the perpetrators were **Steven Kazmierczak** (Northern Illinois University shooter) and **Nikolas Cruz** (Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School

shooter)

9 April Eric Harris's birthday; Alex H	Iribal committed his attack on this date; he wanted
--	---

it to be on 20 April, the anniversary of Columbine, but that date fell on a

weekend, so he chose Harris's birthday

19 April Anniversary of the Oklahoma City bombing and the burning of the Branch

Davidian compound in Waco, Texas; Eric Harris was influenced by both attacks

and possibly planned his attack close to this date because of his fixation

20 April In addition to the Columbine High School attacks, Sky Bouche (Forest High

School shooter) committed his attack on this date; others have planned to

commit attacks on this anniversary but were thwarted

30 August Kip Kinkel's birthday; Alvaro Castillo (Orange High School shooter) chose to

commit his attack on Kinkel's birthday

11 September Dylan Klebold's birthday; reference to this date may be indicative of either

targeted violence or terrorism
