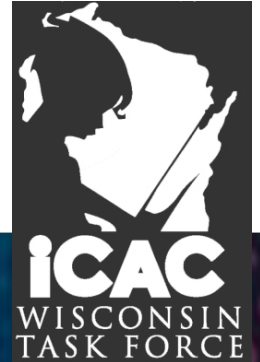


PROTECTING STUDENTS FROM ONLINE SEXTORTION

Jesse Crowe has conducted hundreds of investigations into the online sexual exploitation of children and presents nationally and internationally on the topic of online exploitation.

In law enforcement since 1993, Jesse has held positions of patrol officer, SRO, Detective, and Detective Sergeant. In 2010 Jesse was hired by the WI Department of Justice Division of Criminal Investigation as a Special Agent and assigned to the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) task force. Jesse now holds the position of Special Agent in Charge and is the ICAC Commander for the Wisconsin ICAC Task Force and the Commander for the DCI Child Abduction Response Team (CART). He also supervises ICAC Investigations in field offices in Madison, Wausau and Eau Claire.

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
