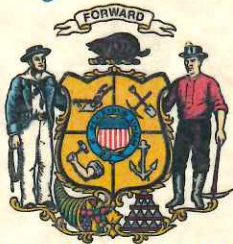

Proclamation

WHEREAS; the historic Wisconsin Athletic Hall of Fame is inducting three new members on Saturday, April 29, 2017 with Hall of Fame inductee Donald Driver serving as emcee; and

WHEREAS; Super Bowl Champion Charles Woodson is joining 137 of the state's greatest athletic icons during the 66th Anniversary event at the historic UW – Milwaukee Panther Arena, the site of the first Wisconsin Athletic Hall of Fame induction event in 1951; and

WHEREAS; Charles Woodson made the most out of his seven seasons with the Green Bay Packers, putting together the best statistical stretch of his career after joining the franchise in 2006; and

WHEREAS; Charles Woodson scored the most defensive touchdowns in Packers' history and is fifth all-time in total interceptions as a Packer; and

WHEREAS; during his tenure in the Green and Gold, Charles Woodson was named AP NFL Defensive Player of the Year, made four Pro Bowls, was named to the NFL's 2000s All-Decade Team, and led the league in interceptions twice; and

WHEREAS; Charles Woodson's biggest accomplishment in a Packers uniform came in his role as a captain for the 2010 season that led to a Lombardi Trophy win in Super Bowl XLV; and

WHEREAS; considered by many to be one of the greatest defensive backs of all-time, Charles Woodson's time with the Green Bay Packers makes him certainly worthy of taking his place in the Wisconsin Athletic Hall of Fame;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
