Proclamation

WHEREAS; the historic Wisconsin Athletic Hall of Fame is inducting three new members on Saturday, April 29, 2017 with Hall of Fame inductee Donald Driver serving as Emcee; and

WHEREAS; LPGA Legend Sherri Steinhauer is joining 137 of the state's greatest athletic icons during the 66th Anniversary event at the historic UW – Milwaukee Panther Arena, the site of the first Wisconsin Athletic Hall of Fame induction event in 1951; and

WHEREAS; Sherri Steinhauer is one of the greatest golfers of all-time from the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS; during her career on the LPGA Tour, Sherri Steinhauer won eight tour events, including two major victories at the Women's British Open in 1998 and 2006; and

WHEREAS; throughout her career, Sherri Steinhauer posted 78 top-10 finishes and served on the LPGA Player Director Board for the 2009 – 2011 seasons, acting as vice president for the 2009 Tour season; and

WHEREAS; prior to officially joining the LPGA Tour, Sherri Steinhauer had three consecutive wins at the Wisconsin State Junior Championship from 1978 – 1980; and

WHEREAS; already a member of the Wisconsin State Golf Association Hall of Fame, Sherri Steinhauer is certainly worthy of taking her place in the Wisconsin Athletic Hall of Fame;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,

SHERRI STEINHAUER DAY


throughout the State of Wisconsin and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
