**EXECUTIVE ORDER #250**

**Relating to a Special Session of the Legislature focused on Economic Development**

**WHEREAS**, since 2011, Wisconsin has become a leader in providing a business climate that encourages research and development, technological innovation, and workforce development; and

**WHEREAS**, the 21<sup>st</sup> century workforce demands economic conditions that foster ingenuity, opportunity, and prosperity; and


**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin's current business climate makes it an excellent location to create an electronics and information technology manufacturing zone;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin pursuant to Article IV, Section 11, and Article V, Section 4 of the Wisconsin Constitution, do hereby require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, to commence at 11 a.m. on August 1, 2017, solely to consider and act upon the following legislation:


1. Legislation relating to promotion of economic development and job retention.
