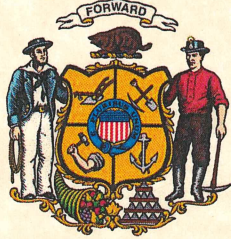

Proclamation

WHEREAS; the City of Milwaukee celebrates Milwaukee Day each year on April 14th; and,
WHEREAS; Milwaukee Day is a celebration of city's area code (414) and the pride Milwaukeeans have in their community; and

WHEREAS; Milwaukee is a thriving cultural hub in Wisconsin, home to Summerfest, the world's largest music festival; and

WHEREAS; for over 155 years, Milwaukee has been the home to Harley-Davidson, one of the world's largest (and loudest) motorcycle manufacturers; and

WHEREAS; Milwaukee proudly celebrates its historic beer culture, from the beginnings of Miller Brewing in 1855 to today, as Eagle Park Brewing Company is named one of the best new breweries in the country; and

WHEREAS; Milwaukee's love of bratwurst sausages is an ode to its German heritage, which is embedded deep into the city's history; and

WHEREAS; Milwaukee's Riverfront is home to the Bronze Fonz, a statue that pays tribute to The Fonz, the city's fictional-son from Happy Days; and

WHEREAS; Milwaukeeans take great pride in cheering for their home teams—including the Milwaukee Bucks, who finished the 2018-2019 regular season with the best record in the NBA, and the Milwaukee Brewers, who are the defending National League Central champions; and

WHEREAS; we make special recognition of Milwaukee's heritage, culture, and traditions on April 14th to commemorate Milwaukee Day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tony Evers, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,
do hereby proclaim April 14, 2019 as

MILWAUKEE DAY

throughout the State of Wisconsin. I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
