WHEREAS; a decade later in 1894, Congress passed an act officiating the first Monday in September of each year as a legal holiday; and

WHEREAS; American workers and labor unions have contributed significantly to improved standards of living and work through their persistence and advocacy, helping to secure 40-hour work weeks, overtime compensation, a minimum wage, Social Security, family leave, other earned benefits, and the right to collectively bargain for future generations of workers; and

WHEREAS; Labor Day provides an opportunity for Wisconsinites to reflect on the contributions of workers and working families, and to be reminded of the dignity of work and the importance of every job, from farmers to steelworkers, educators to laborers, and personal care workers to food services employees; and

WHEREAS; on this and each Labor Day, we renew our commitment to fighting for equal pay, livable wages, safe and inclusive workplaces, and an economy that works for everyone by striving for closing the gender pay gap for women and women of color, making healthcare and benefits accessible and affordable, protecting the right to organize, and ensuring no one is denied an employment opportunity because of who they are or who they love;
