## 2019 BILL

1     **AN ACT to create** 165.85 (4) (a) 7. d. of the statutes; **relating to:** law enforcement  
2             training on use-of-force options.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill requires each law enforcement officer to annually complete at least eight hours of training on use-of-force options and techniques a law enforcement officer may use to de-escalate a potentially unstable situation.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

3             **SECTION 1.** 165.85 (4) (a) 7. d. of the statutes is created to read:  
4             165.85 (4) (a) 7. d. Each officer who is subject to this subdivision shall annually  
5             complete at least 8 hours of scenario-based training on use-of-force options,  
6             focusing on skills and tactics that minimize the likelihood of using force, including  
7             de-escalation tactics. In this subd. 7. d., “de-escalation tactics” are actions and  
8             techniques used by law enforcement officers to slow down or stabilize a potentially
