EXECUTIVE ORDER #93

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Former State Representative Dr. Jacob ("Doc") Albert Hines

WHEREAS, on March 3rd, 2020, former State Representative Dr. Jacob Hines passed away at the age of 92;

WHEREAS, State Representative Hines served as the state representative from Wisconsin's 42nd District for 7 years;

WHEREAS, State Representative Hines served as the chairman of the Public Health Committee for 6 years;

WHEREAS, State Representative Hines not only served his district in the State Assembly, but was also an accomplished veterinarian and veteran of World War II in the European Theater;

WHEREAS, State Representative Hines was a dedicated public servant, and the people of Wisconsin mourn his death; and

WHEREAS, a private memorial services will be held on October 3, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations at the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on **Saturday, October 3, 2020** and ending at sunset on that date.
