PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

1 **AN ACT to amend** 46.535 of the statutes; **relating to:** crisis training for law
2 enforcement officers and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill increases the amount of moneys that the Department of Health Services is required to award in grants for mental health crisis intervention team training for law enforcement agencies and correctional officers from \$250,000 per fiscal biennium to \$500,000 per fiscal biennium.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 46.535 of the statutes is amended to read:
4 **46.535 Crisis intervention training grants.** From the appropriation under
5 s. 20.435 (5) (cd), the department shall award grants in the total amount of \$250,000
6 \$500,000 in each fiscal biennium for mental health crisis intervention team training
7 for law enforcement agencies, as described in s. 165.77 (1) (c), and correctional
8 officers, as defined in s. 102.475 (8) (a).

1 **SECTION 2. Fiscal changes.**

2 (1) CRISIS INTERVENTION TRAINING GRANTS. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3)
3 for the appropriation to the department of health services under s. 20.435 (5) (cd),
4 the dollar amount for fiscal year 2021-22 is increased by \$125,000 to award grants
5 for mental health crisis intervention team training under s. 46.535. In the schedule
6 under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the department of health services under
7 s. 20.435 (5) (cd), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2022-23 is increased by \$125,000
8 to award grants for mental health crisis intervention team training under s. 46.535.
