EXECUTIVE ORDER #138

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Volunteer Firefighter Gary E. Berg of the North Prairie Fire Department

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2021, volunteer firefighter Gary E. Berg, of North Prairie, passed away after contracting COVID-19 in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, firefighter Gary E. Berg served the people of the State of Wisconsin and North Prairie for 36 years;

WHEREAS, firefighter Gary E. Berg was a beloved husband, father, and grandfather who personified exceptional dedication and bravery;

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Wisconsin and North Prairie are forever grateful for the service, selflessness, and sacrifice of firefighter Gary E. Berg of the North Prairie Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, services for firefighter Gary E. Berg will be held in Genesee on Saturday, October 23, 2021, before he is laid to rest in North Prairie.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Saturday, October 23, 2021, and ending at sunset on that date.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-second day of October in the year of two thousand twenty-one.
