EXECUTIVE ORDER #180

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and
the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff
as a Mark of Respect for Aundre Cross**

WHEREAS, on December 9, 2022, Aundre Cross was tragically killed in a senseless act of violence while delivering mail in Milwaukee;

WHEREAS, Cross was a dedicated public servant who had dutifully served in his role as a mail carrier for the United States Postal Service for eighteen years;

WHEREAS, Cross will be remembered as a hard-working and loving husband, father, and minister who enjoyed singing gospel music and making others smile;

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin join his wife, Mia, his children, and all his family, friends, and community members in mourning his passing while also celebrating the life that he lived and legacy he leaves behind; and

WHEREAS, services for Aundre Cross will be held on Thursday, December 22, 2022, in Milwaukee.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on Thursday, December 22, 2022, and ending at sunset on that date.
