2023 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT to *repeal* 41.11 (5), 41.12 (3) and 41.24 (3); and to *amend* 41.11 (1) (h) of the statutes; **relating to:** modifying the Department of Tourism's reporting duties and repealing requirements to distribute cheese, submit a financial statement, and use famous residents in marketing.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 41.11 (1) (h) of the statutes is amended to read:

41.11 (1) (h) Annually report to the ~~senate natural resources committee and the assembly committee on tourism~~ appropriate standing committees of the legislature under s. 13.172 (3) the activities, marketing efforts,

receipts, and disbursements of the department for the previous fiscal year. The report under this paragraph shall include information on the marketing efforts conducted for the Frank Lloyd Wright Trail established under s. 84.10255.

SECTION 2. 41.11 (5) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 41.12 (3) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 4. 41.24 (3) of the statutes is repealed.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
