2023 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT *to create* 69.18 (1m) (c) 3. of the statutes; **relating to:** providing additional information fields regarding occupation on death records.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 69.18 (1m) (c) 3. of the statutes is created to read:

69.18 (1m) (c) 3. Beginning on September 1, 2025, data on the decedent's usual occupation in a format directed by the state registrar that allows inclusion of up to 2 additional occupations, if applicable.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
