Dear Governor Evers:

This is in response to your August 27, 2025, request for a major disaster declaration for the State of Wisconsin as a result of severe storms, straight-line winds, flooding, and mudslides during the period of August 9-12, 2025. You specifically requested Individual Assistance for Milwaukee, Washington, and Waukesha Counties; Public Assistance for Door, Grant, Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Washington, and Waukesha Counties; and Hazard Mitigation statewide.

The September 11, 2025, major disaster declaration FEMA-4892-DR authorized Individual Assistance for Milwaukee, Washington, and Waukesha Counties.

The impact to individuals and households was significant in the areas designated for Individual Assistance. However, based on the results of the joint federal, state, and local government Preliminary Damage Assessments, it has been determined that the Public Assistance program under FEMA-4892-DR is not warranted. Therefore, your request for the Public Assistance Assistance program is denied.

This denial may be appealed within 30 days after the date of this letter. The appeal, along with additional information justifying the appeal, should be submitted to me through Michael Chesney, Acting Regional Administrator, FEMA Region V, located at 536 South Clark Street, Floor 6, Chicago, Illinois 60605.
