EXECUTIVE ORDER #279

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff to Mark the Fourth Anniversary of the Waukesha Christmas Parade Tragedy

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2021, as community members gathered to celebrate the holiday season at the annual Waukesha Christmas Parade, a senseless act of violence shook the community, the state of Wisconsin, and the country, injuring dozens of people, affecting countless others, and taking the lives of six individuals;

WHEREAS, Tamara Durand, 52; Wilhelm Hospel, 81; Jane Kulich, 52; Leanna Owen, 71; Virginia Sorenson, 79; and Jackson Sparks, 8, are remembered for the light that they brought to the world, which lives on through the kindness, courage, empathy, and strength of the Waukesha community and the unity and love that has been shared with Waukesha by people from across Wisconsin and around the nation;

WHEREAS, in 2023, the Waukesha community dedicated the Main Street Parade Memorial, and last year, on the third anniversary of the Waukesha Christmas Parade attack, the Waukesha community dedicated the Parade Memorial at Grede Park to honor the lives of the six individuals lost and the many survivors whose lives have been forever changed;

WHEREAS, on this fourth anniversary, the state also recognizes and honors the first responders, law enforcement agencies, medical professionals, and community members who acted quickly to respond and provide aid and support to their neighbors, even at great personal risk in the face of fear and danger; and

WHEREAS, on the anniversary of this fateful attack, the state and all Wisconsinites join survivors, families, friends, neighbors, and loved ones in honoring the lives that were mercilessly taken far too soon and the strength shown by the entire Waukesha community on that day and in the years since.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin, beginning at sunrise on Friday, November 21, 2025, and ending at sunset on that date.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this nineteenth day of November in the year of two thousand twenty-five.
