

2025 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT *to amend* 23.33 (1) (ng) 1. a. and 23.33 (1) (ng) 2. a. of the statutes; **relating to:** the weight limit for utility terrain vehicles.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 23.33 (1) (ng) 1. a. of the statutes is amended to read:

23.33 (1) (ng) 1. a. A weight, without fluids, of 3,000 3,500 pounds or less.

SECTION 2. 23.33 (1) (ng) 2. a. of the statutes is amended to read:

23.33 (1) (ng) 2. a. It does not meet federal motor

vehicle safety standards in effect on July 1, 2012; is not a golf cart, low-speed vehicle, dune buggy, mini-truck, or tracked vehicle; is designed to be used primarily off of a highway; and has, and was originally manufactured with, a weight, without fluids, of not more than 3,000 3,500 pounds.

SECTION 3. Effective dates. This act takes effect on January 6, 2026, except as follows:

(1) If the day of publication is on or after January 7, 2026, this act takes effect on March 1, 2026.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
