2025 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT to amend 175.51 (1m) (a) 2. of the statutes; relating to: age for the issuance of a Missing Child Alert.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 175.51 (1m) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

175.51 (1m) (a) 2. A person who has not attained

the age of 18 years, whose location is unknown, and whose situation does not qualify for another alert and the person is believed to be incapable of returning home without assistance due to a physical or mental condition or disability or the person has not attained the age of ~~10~~ 12 years.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
