

2025 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT to create 20.566 (2) (x), 20.566 (2) (y), 20.566 (2) (z) and 73.50 of the statutes; relating to: levy adjustment grants and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

SECTION 2. 20.566 (2) (x) of the statutes is created to read:

20.566 (2) (x) *Village of Oregon levy adjustment grant.* From the local government fund, the amounts in the schedule for the grant to the village of Oregon under s. 73.50 (1).

SECTION 3. 20.566 (2) (y) of the statutes is created to read:

20.566 (2) (y) *Town of Oregon levy adjustment grant.* From the local government fund, the amounts in the schedule for the grant to the town of Oregon under s. 73.50 (2).

SECTION 4. 20.566 (2) (z) of the statutes is created to read:

20.566 (2) (z) *Town of Rutland levy adjustment grant.* From the local government fund, the amounts in the schedule for the grant to the town of Rutland under s. 73.50 (3).

SECTION 5. 73.50 of the statutes is created to read:
73.50 Levy adjustment grants. No later than June 30 of each year, the department of revenue shall award the following grants:

(1) The amounts appropriated for that fiscal year under s. 20.566 (2) (x) to the village of Oregon.

(2) The amounts appropriated for that fiscal year under s. 20.566 (2) (y) to the town of Oregon.

(3) The amounts appropriated for that fiscal year under s. 20.566 (2) (z) to the town of Rutland.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
