2025 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT relating to: marking the Mississippi River Trail.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) MISSISSIPPI RIVER TRAIL.

(a) *Notice.* On the date on which the department of transportation determines that each municipality located on the route of the Great River Road, as established in s. 84.107, has approved a resolution expressing support for the Mississippi River Trail effort and identifying and confirming a route for the Mississippi River Trail through each municipality, the department shall notify the legislative reference bureau. The legislative reference bureau shall publish a notice in the Wisconsin administrative register that specifies that date.

(b) *Signs.* No later than 18 months after the date specified in par. (a), the department of transportation shall procure and erect signs marking the Mississippi River Trail.

(c) *Funding.* The department of transportation may submit a request to the joint committee on finance to supplement an appropriation of the department of transportation for the procurement and erection of signs under par. (b). Notwithstanding s. 13.101 (3), the committee is not required to find that an emergency exists prior to supplementing an appropriation of the department of transportation for the procurement and erection of signs under par. (b).

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."
