2025 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT to renumber and amend 289.67 (1) (b); to create 289.67 (1) (b) 2. of the statutes; **relating to:** retention of environmental repair fees by certain municipal solid waste facilities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 289.67 (1) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 289.67 (1) (b) 1. and amended to read:

289.67 (1) (b) 1. ~~The~~ Except as provided in subd. 2., the owner or operator of a licensed solid or hazardous waste disposal facility shall collect the environmental repair fee from the generator, a person who arranges for disposal on behalf of one or more generators or an intermediate hauler and shall pay to the department the amount of the fees required to be collected according to the amount of solid or hazardous waste received and dis-

posed of at the facility during the preceding reporting period.

SECTION 2. 289.67 (1) (b) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

289.67 (1) (b) 2. If the owner or operator of a municipal solid waste facility receives a loan under the clean water fund program under s. 281.58 for waste water treatment infrastructure, the owner or operator of the municipal solid waste facility may retain, of the amounts collected under subd. 1., an amount equal to the total principal and interest owed on the loan while the loan is in repayment.
