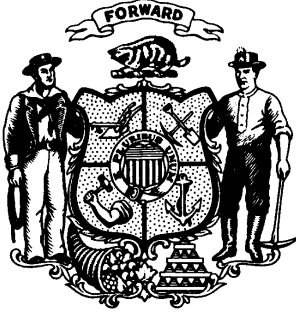

2025 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT to amend 18.08 (7), 20.505 (1) (mb) and 341.135 (2m) of the statutes; to affect 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, section 9444 (1); relating to: correction bill for 2025 Wisconsin Act 15 and making an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 18.08 (7) of the statutes is amended to read:

18.08 (7) Notwithstanding sub. (3), moneys transferred under 2023 Wisconsin Act 19, section 9251 (1), cannot be commingled with other moneys in the capital improvement fund and all earnings on or income from investments of the moneys transferred under 2023 Wisconsin Act 19, section 9251 (1), and all excess moneys so transferred that are not used to fund building projects authorized in the 2023-25 Authorized State Building Program or the 2025-27 Authorized State Building Program, shall be deposited into or transferred to the general fund.

SECTION 2. 20.505 (1) (mb) of the statutes, as affected by 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, section 87, is amended to read:

20.505 (1) (mb) *Federal aid.* All moneys received from the federal government not otherwise appropriated under this section, as authorized by the governor under s. 16.54, to carry out the purposes for which received. In each year of the 2025-27 fiscal biennium, \$5,000,000 of the amounts received under this appropriation account shall be transferred to the appropriation account under s. 20.115 (3) (m). One million dollars in interest earnings from this appropriation account is transferred

to s. 20.285 (1) (m) in the fiscal year that begins in 2025. In fiscal year 2025-26, of the interest earnings in this appropriation account, \$110,000,000 is transferred to the appropriation account under s. 20.437 (2) (mf). To the extent that any interest earnings remain in this appropriation account after all transfers of interest earnings required under this paragraph and under 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, section ~~9452~~ 9251 (3), those remaining amounts are transferred to the appropriation account under s. 20.437 (2) (mh) and, as provided under 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, section 9106 (3m), to the appropriation account under s. 20.437 (2) (dz). All transfers of interest earnings from this appropriation account shall be made by July 1, 2027.

SECTION 3. 20.505 (1) (mb) of the statutes, as affected by 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, section 87m, is amended to read:

20.505 (1) (mb) *Federal aid.* All moneys received from the federal government not otherwise appropriated under this section, as authorized by the governor under s. 16.54, to carry out the purposes for which received. In each year of the 2025-27 fiscal biennium, \$5,000,000 of the amounts received under this appropriation account shall be transferred to the appropriation account under s. 20.115 (3) (m). One million dollars in interest earnings from this appropriation account is transferred to s. 20.285 (1) (m) in the fiscal year that begins in 2025.

* Section 991.11, WISCONSIN STATUTES: Effective date of acts. "Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication."

To the extent that any interest earnings remain in this appropriation account after all transfers of interest earnings required under this paragraph and under 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, section ~~9152~~ 9251 (3), those remaining amounts are transferred to the appropriation account under s. 20.437 (2) (mh) and, as provided under 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, section 9106 (3m), to the appropriation account under s. 20.437 (2) (dz). All transfers of interest earnings from this appropriation account shall be made by July 1, 2027.

SECTION 4. 341.135 (2m) of the statutes, as created by 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, is amended to read:

341.135 (2m) FEES. Beginning with registration plates issued on October 1, ~~2026~~ 2025, the department shall assess a fee of \$6 per plate for the issuance of new registration plates that are not replacement plates for which a fee is collected under s. 341.16. The fee under this subsection is an addition to any other fee required for the registration of a vehicle.

SECTION 5. 2025 Wisconsin Act 15, section 9444 (1) is amended to read:

[2025 Wisconsin Act 15] Section 9444 (1) HEAVY

VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES. The treatment of s. 341.25 ~~(2)-(e)-to-(q)~~ (2m) takes effect on October 1, 2025.

SECTION 6. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) If a project previously satisfying s. 16.855 (1g) (f) is enumerated in the 2025-27 Authorized State Building Program, the department of administration may assume any existing architect or engineer contract with respect to the project, notwithstanding s. 16.867.

SECTION 7. Fiscal changes.

(1) PROTECTIVE SERVICES HEARING PROTECTION. In the schedule under s. 20.005 (3) for the appropriation to the Joint Committee on Finance under s. 20.865 (4) (a), the dollar amount for fiscal year 2025-26 is increased by \$2,600,000 for the purpose of the public protective services hearing protection program under s. 85.65.

SECTION 8. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after publication, except as follows:

(1) The treatment of s. 20.505 (1) (mb) (by SECTION 3) takes effect on July 1, 2026, or on the 2nd day after publication, whichever is later.
