## 2025 WISCONSIN ACT

AN ACT *to amend* 118.51 (3m) (b) 4. of the statutes; **relating to:** alternative open enrollment application procedures for residency change based on military orders.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** 118.51 (3m) (b) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

118.51 (3m) (b) 4. The place of residence of the pupil's parent or guardian and of the pupil has changed as a result of military orders. An application made on the basis of this criteria is not valid unless the nonresident school board receives the application no later than

~~30~~ 90 days after the date on which the military orders changing the place of residence were issued. For purposes of this subdivision, a military order includes an order from any branch of the U.S. armed forces, a reserve component of the U.S. armed forces, the state defense force, or the national guard of any state.

**SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

(1) This act first applies to applications under s. 118.51 (3m) that are received on the effective date of this subsection.
