**WHEREAS**, health care professionals, first responders and caregivers are ready to aid the people of Wyoming 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

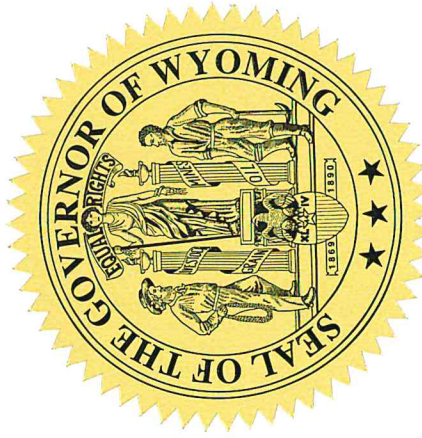
